**Background:** An opportunity has arisen for a motivated, clinically-trained individual with some experience in epidemiology to join our team for a 3-month period. The post holder will be expected to work to develop a large grant proposal to study non-alcoholic fatty liver disease in low and middle-income countries (LMICs).

The post holder will be expected to travel to collaborating centres, predominantly in India, to set up and maintain cohort studies at these sites. Data management and grant preparation will be key aspects of this role.

The position will be based at the Institute of Hepatology, London, which is an interdisciplinary independent research facility based in a new state-of-the-art building on the King's College London/King's College Hospital campus in south east London at Denmark Hill.
